

HONORS COURSE / CREDIT
STUDENT / PARENT CONTRACT

All students have the opportunity to earn 5 points for the Honors Option in English, History, Science (Physics is an Honors Course), and Mathematics (Pre-Calculus and Calculus are Honors courses). Expectations in both quantity and quality of work are higher as additional quality points will apply. These expectations involve extending the regular coursework that will also be graded by a higher standard of performance.

HONORS STUDENTS WILL:

Complete all regular assignments and projects on time (no late assignments allowed) and in a quality manner.

Complete projects and assignments as designated by the teacher (An Honors Option outline of assignments will be provided by teachers for the Honors Option in his or her course.)

Complete "Honors only" questions on tests and quizzes if this is required by the teacher.

Maintain an 85% or higher average in every graded category (homework, tests, quizzes, class work / projects, participation) evaluated in the first progress report. Honors students are expected to continue to maintain an 85% or better average in all categories for the remainder of the course.

It is recommended that teachers keep a portfolio of some or all assignments for potential review at the end of the year.

Students who meet these criteria will be allowed to continue pursuing this class for honors credit. In the event the student is unable to maintain the required 85% in the second semester, no honors credit will be given for that semester.

In addition to academic excellence, each student must maintain a position of exemplary behavior, character and respect for the faculty and his / her peers.
